Everest Marathon and other world-wide races. Brent Weigner is no new comer to extreme races. In 1999, he became the first person to run ultra marathons on all seven continents. Many in Cheyenne will know him as a former geography teacher and cross-country coach at McCormick Junior High School. This remarkable man has completed 218 marathons and ultra marathons around the world including races in the Arctic and Antarctic.
